

### Brazil Tax Conference 2023 September 28, 2023 – São Paulo

In today's globalised and transparent world, individuals, companies and legal professionals face a set of new and demanding challenges in relation to regulatory and tax compliance. Recent developments in the area of tax transparency and the exchange of information for tax purposes have created a competitive landscape in which efficient compliance with tax laws is the key to success.

The Brazil Tax Conference 2023 will discuss the most recent changes in Brazilian tax legislation, from both a domestic and international perspective, including the analysis of comparative law in selected jurisdictions. Practical case studies will also be presented on tax planning in inbound and outbound scenarios for various selected jurisdictions, such as Switzerland, Liechtenstein and Mexico.
